






HOLESAWS

Holesaws, also named as hole cutters are saw blades of circular shape, used in a power drill. Holesaws produce a core of waste material. They are more efficient than twist drill or spade drills when drilling relatively large holes. They typically have a pilot drill bit at their centre to guide the teeth of the blade and are mounted in an arbor.
